

## Using a Strava route for an Athletics Yukon virtual Event

When Athletics Yukon posts a virtual event through Strava we will try our best to flag the trail, especially for any trail portions. However, this may not always be the case and you may want to have a copy of the route on your phone. These instructions will help guide you through how to do this.

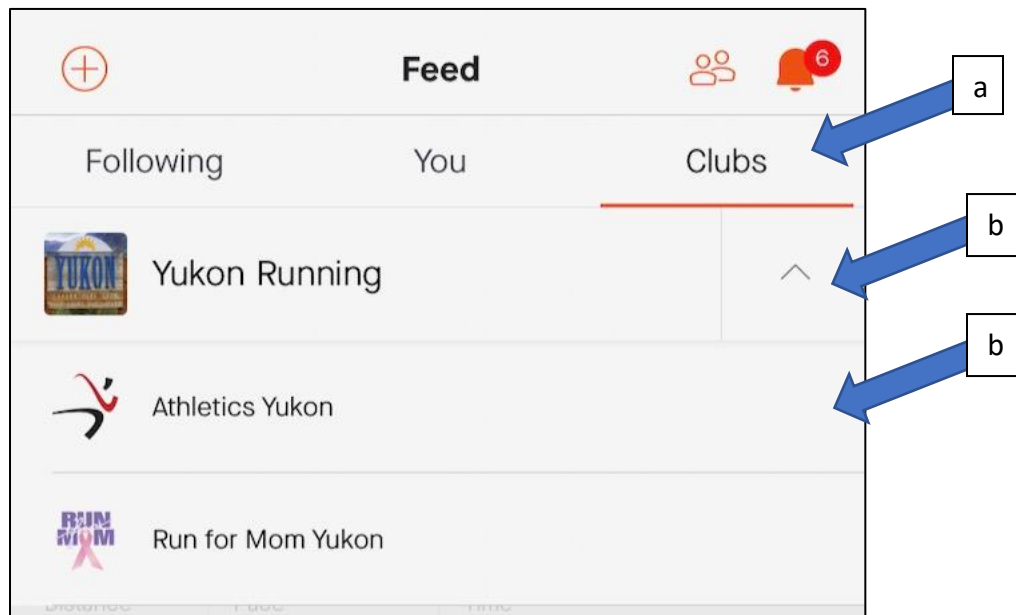
Note: Not all of our Virtual events will have a route attached, and routes only show on Strava for **upcoming** events. We post our virtual events for 11:30PM on event day to allow you to see the route the full day during the virtual event, we do not expect anyone to start at 11:30PM.

This document assumes you have loaded the Strava App on your phone and you have joined the Athletics Yukon Strava club.

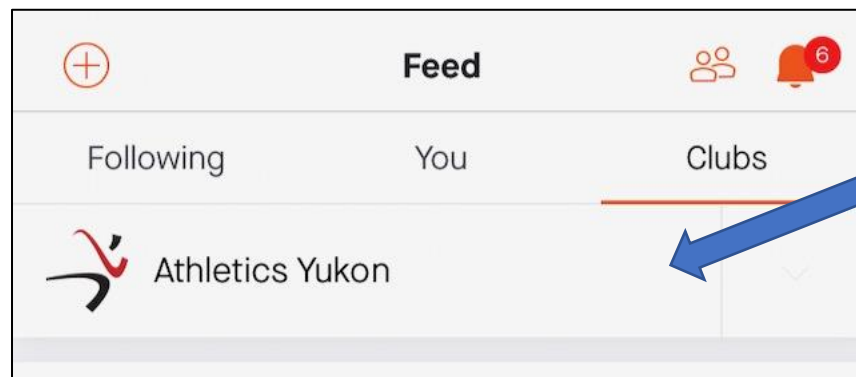
### 1. Load the Strava app, and find the Athletics Yukon Club feed

Load the Strava app, and find the club:

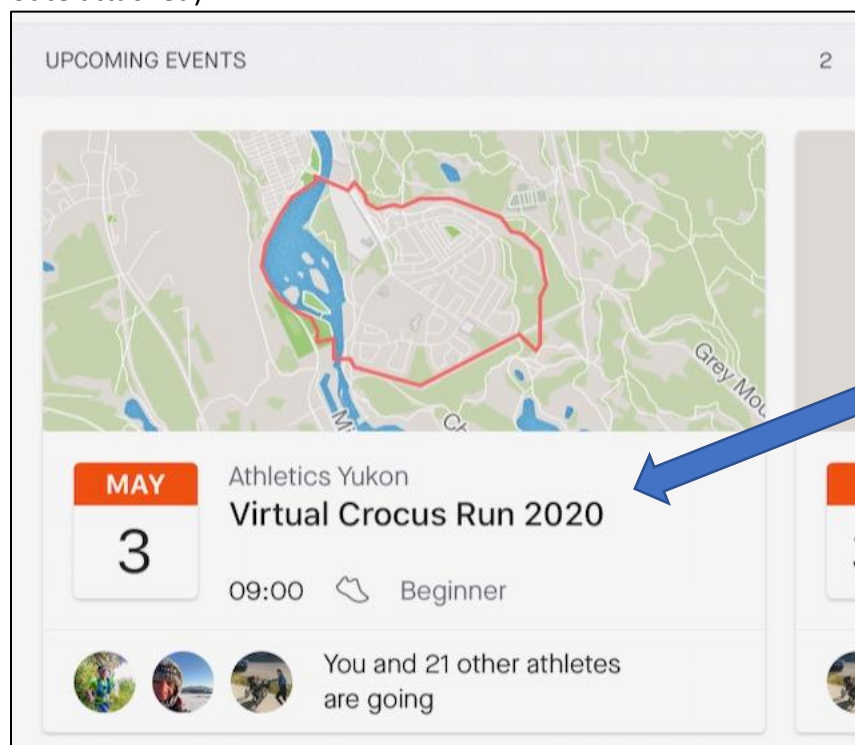
- a. Click Clubs under your feeds
- b. If not already selected select the Athletics Yukon club (you may have to click the little box to see all the clubs you belong too).



2. View the Athletics Yukon club  
Click on the Athletics Yukon banner



3. View the upcoming events  
Scroll down through the club page and find and click on the upcoming even you want to use (if there is a route attached).



4. When viewing the event, you can now select view route, and use route.
